## Hopeful Expansion

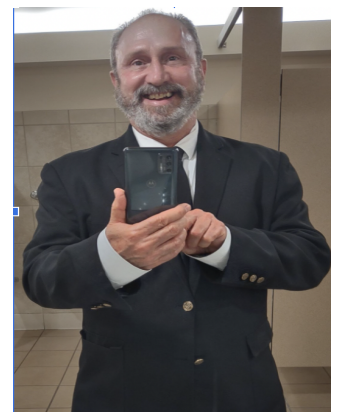


Leaders were busy this month responding to multiple RFP's in hopes of expanding our programs again. We are grateful for our talented grants department.

We are excited to report that Jack Britt is now employed with Superstore Industries. After over 20 years incarcerated, he is making a good income and has also helped other crew members get hired!

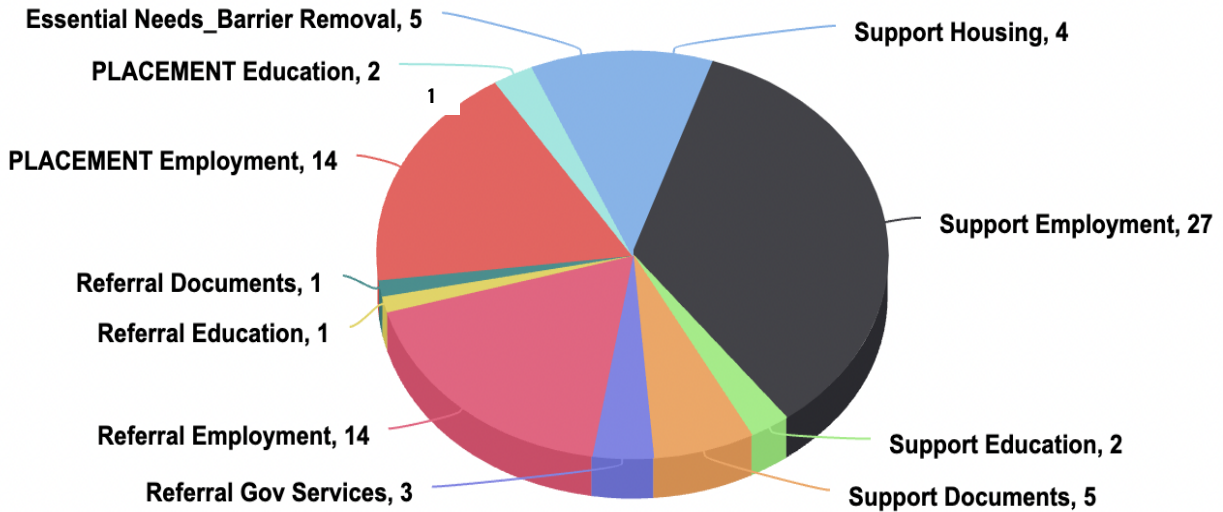
