

That's A Wrap for Woolsey Fire Clean-Up Crew



The Five Keys Fire Clean-up Crew has finished the remediation of Charmlee Wilderness Park in Malibu CA. The entire park was ablaze during the Woolsey Fire in November 2018. After the fire, the park was closed for over two years. Our hard working Fire Crew has spent the last 20 months, restoring hiking trails, clearing emergency access roads, and filling in trenches caused by erosion. Now, the city of Malibu and its patrons will be able to enjoy all the park has to offer. 
More Highlights

His assistance over a three day period has given a record number of our crew members an opportunity for a great career.

The SA(M) Program is a temporary position specifically for those participating in a Special Program contract. It has led to permanent employment with Caltrans for our past participants.


